Youth Volunteer Requirements

Young volunteers make a tremendous contribution to the Cleveland County Rescue Mission. There are lots of opportunities for youth who are under the age of 18 to get involved and learn about hunger and homelessness issues throughout the area.

Waivers and Chaperones

All youth volunteers must have a waiver signed by a parent or guardian and must be actively supervised by an adult/parent to participate. Please follow the student-to-adult ratio below when registering to volunteer:

- Grade 10-12: 5 students to 1 adult
- Grade 7-9: 4 students to 1 adult
- Grade 3-6: 3 students to 1 adult
- Grade K-2: 1 student to **1 parent/guardian**

Please note: Everyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

The minimum age to volunteer at CCRM is 5 years old; however, we recommend that groups of youth be 3rd grade and older. CCRM staff reserve the right to amend volunteer scheduling. In order to make sure youth are properly involved, the Cleveland County Rescue Mission adheres to these minimum age requirements for volunteering at the facility: 3rd grade or older with waiver and adult supervision; volunteers Grade K-2 should be directly supervised by their **parent or guardian**.
